





THE CORNWALL BEAVER PROJECT

- To stop beavers eating the trees they put one metre of PVA glue onto the bottom of the tree or a sheet of wire around the base of the tree reaching at least one metre high.
- The specific name for a beaver is an Eurasian Beaver.
- Beavers have been around for about 6 years now in the UK and things have changed greatly for the greater good.
- There are wild beavers living in the Tamar.
- The reason beavers build dams is because the best place for them is in the river - it is also the best place for their babies.
- They are herbivores and also have very short attention spans.





We find out about famous gymnasts, and Hannah shows us all the different moves.


Katelyn Ohashi

Simone Biles is a world-renowned international gymnast who started gymnastics when she was 6 years old. She has won 32 Olympic medals and is only 24 years of age.




Danell Leyva





As the sun began to rise, they began their adventure towards the centre of the Amazon. They had been told they were to face a challenge...so they were awaiting




After much discussion, they turned around and said to the snake: “Cut the bench in half, then put them together and two halves make a whole. A hole to escape.”

But there was the girl. Still swimming.




About Newquay

How much do you know about the history of our town?
Marcia takes a quick look back through time.



- People have lived here and taken in the sea views for thousands of years.
- By medieval times a small fishing village had sprung up around the sheltered bay we now know as Newquay harbour.
- Until the 15th century Newquay was known by its Cornish language name 'Towan Blystra'.
- Then in the mid 1400's Edmund Lacey, the Bishop of Exeter, sourced the funds to build a 'new quay' and then the town became known as 'Newquay'.
- By 1800 the population had grown to about 1300 people and the simple wooden quay was replaced with the current stone harbour.
- With the Victorian era, beach holidays for the wealthy had begun and by the turn of the 19th century several large hotels around the town had been built.
- In the 1960's a new leisure sport from the US came to the UK: surfing, and it soon found a home at Newquay.
