Decider Skills Training

We are excited that all of our children will be working with the Mental Health Schools Team in the Spring Term every week for support with Decider.

Decider Skills are a set of life skills (12 at Key Stage 2, 4 at Key stage 1) based on cognitive behaviour therapy (CBT). These are taught across 4 sessions over 4 weeks.



The skills are aimed at helping young people to recognise and understand their emotions, and promote positive mental health. They are include basic problem solving and conflict de-escalation skills, and have a strong focus on supporting children in regulating their own emotions.
