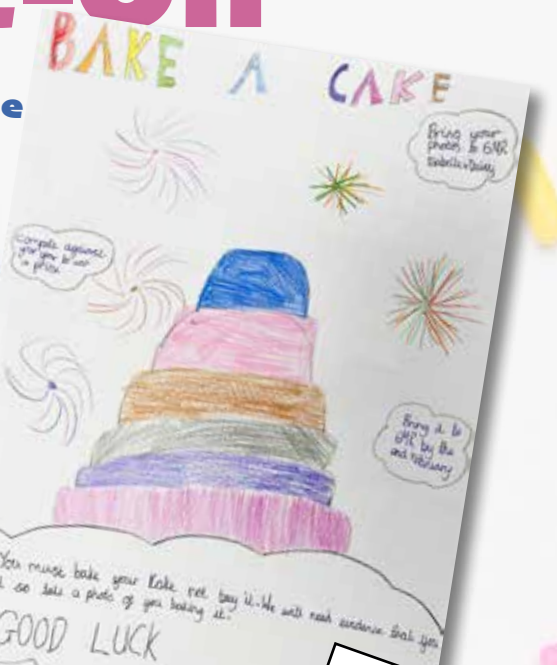
# The BUZZ Bake-Off

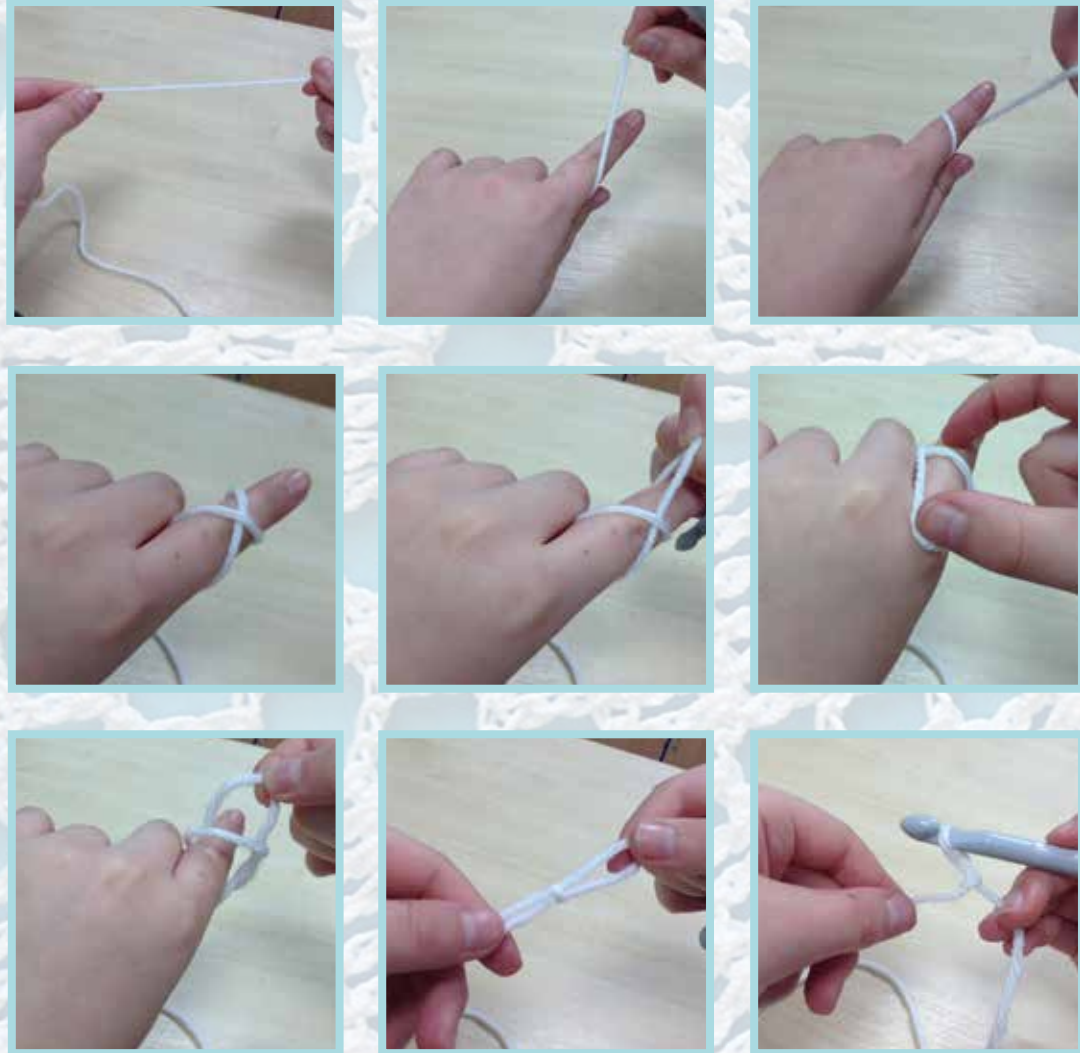
# How to... *crochet*

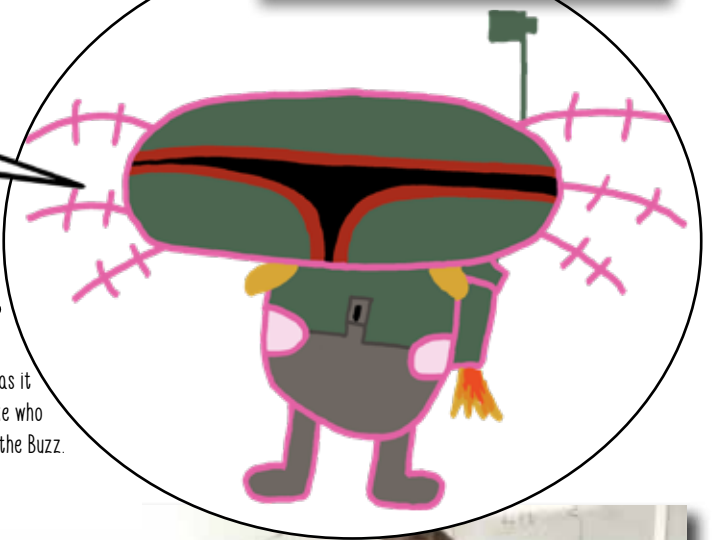
