Dear Parents and Carers of Year 5,

We are really looking forward to the Year 5 residential at Porthpean Outdoor Education Centre. This will take place from **Wednesday 1st May to Friday 3rd May 2024**.

There will be a meeting regarding the residential trip for parents and carers on **Wednesday 17th April at 5pm in the Main Hall.** We understand that not all parents will be able to make this meeting, and so we will make sure that the PowerPoint is sent by email afterwards.

The kit list is attached and will mostly consist of:

- Sleeping bag, pillow, 2 towels, toiletries toothbrush/paste, shower gel/soap, shampoo, hairbrush & hair ties.
- Sports/old clothes that you do not mind getting wet/muddy, swimwear, waterproof trousers (if you have them).
- Waterproof coat, waterproof shoes, 2 trainers, warm fleece, sun hat, warm hat for evenings, rash vest for wetsuit.

Pupils will need a packed lunch for the first day of their trip and a reusable water bottle. Pupils who receive Free School Meals should order a packed lunch via ParentPay for the first day of their camp. Further information will be given about this at the meeting.

At the end of this letter, you will find the online link to complete all the information we need regarding allergies, medical concerns and food requirements for the camp.

Please use the link to give permission for your child to attend and to make us aware of any medical and dietary requirements, including:

- Vegetarian or Vegan
- Intolerances e.g. Gluten, lactose
- Allergies
- Any medical issues to be aware of or medicine that will need to be administered during this trip.

CLOTHING REQUIRED:

- T-shirts/tops (include a long sleeve top)
- · Waterproof, lightweight jacket for the daytime
- Warm coat for evenings
- Warm fleece or hoodie
- Joggers/leggings/tracksuits. We do not recommend jeans, as they do not dry easily and can be uncomfortable when wet.
- Waterproof over-trousers, if required/available
- Shorts
- Baseball hat/sun hat for the daytime
- Woolly hat/beanie for evenings
- Swimwear to include costume/trunks/board shorts, plus a rash vest and jelly shoes/wetsuit boots if available
- Underwear and socks
- · Warm, cosy nightwear. Onesies are very popular
- 1 pair of old trainers for land activities. These need to offer a good grip
- 1 pair of old trainers for water activities. These also need to
 offer a good grip. Plimsolls and wetsuit shoes are also suitable.
 Flip-flops, Crocs and Reefs are not suitable for water activities
- 1 pair of trainers/other shoes to wear at meal times and in the evening
- · Flip-flops/sandals for use in the shower

OTHER ITEMS:

- Sunscreen
- Reusable water bottle
- 1 x towel for water activities
- 1 x towel for showers
- Large carrier bag or bin bag for wet/dirty items
- Sleeping bag
- Pillow
- Wash bag to include toothpaste, toothbrush, body wash, shampoo, and soap. Please do not pack perfume or aerosols
- Hair brush and hair ties for long hair
- Torch
- Pencil & copy of this Kit List (see below!)
- We respectfully ask that any phones, smart watches and screens are left at home.
- There is no need for children to bring any money with them as there will be no gift shop on site.
